Disease states covered	PBC	All diseases in Intercept's areas of interest (progressive non-viral liver diseases, including PBC, PSC, NASH and BA)
Format and purpose	<u>Project-based</u> : to encourage the development of innovative programs and solutions to improve the lives of people with PBC (e.g., creation of education materials, support groups, apps, awareness initiatives, screening days, symptom management guides, etc.)	<u>Clinical studies</u> : to advance research or enhance disease understanding
Timing	Application window mid May – September 8; winners announced in October	Year-round submissions, quarterly grant decisions
Funding amount	Up to \$30,000 for short-term projects that are funded for up to 1 year	N/A
Review process	Reviewed by committee of senior Intercept representatives and 3 external judges representing perspectives from the medical and patient communities; evaluated based on eligibility criteria, demonstration of innovation, clear purpose, methodology, and budget	Reviewed by Intercept's scientific review committee for scientific merit (as well as safety, legal, ethical, and budgetary considerations)
